




Fedora EPEL Mirror Stats (Stacked)


epel: name for arch aarch64



epel: name for arch ppc64le












ppc64le (0.3%) aarch64 (2.0%) x86_64 (97.7%)

epel: age over time (share)




epel: name over time (stacked)






